

TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN CHAPTER 226, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE XX, "VEHICLE PARKING RESTRICTIONS", SECTION 226-77 PROHIBITION OF UNREGISTERED VEHICLES IN PARKING YARDS AND PARKING PLACES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Manalapan, County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey that Chapter 226, Article XX "Vehicle Parking Restrictions", Section 226-77 Prohibition of Unregistered Vehicles in Parking Yards and Parking Places.

Section I.

§ ARTICLE XX, Vehicle Parking Restrictions

§ 226-76. No Parking of certain vehicles any time; exceptions.

A. through C. No Change.

[§ 226-77. (Reserved)]

§ 226-77. Prohibition of Unregistered Vehicles in Parking Yards and Parking Places.

A. Unless authorized by a sworn Law Enforcement Officer, no person shall operate, park, leave or be in possession of a motor vehicle which is unregistered or has a suspended registration in any parking yards (lots) and parking places, which are open to the public or to which the public is invited whether owned or maintained by a governmental entity or in conjunction with any business or enterprise whether public, quasi-public or private.

[§ 226-78. through § 226-82. (Reserved)]

§ 226-78. Exemptions.

This Section shall not apply to:

- A. Private property to which the public is not invited, such as residential lots.
- B. Motor vehicles which are exempted from registration under Title 39 of the New Jersey Statutes, such as car dealer inventory.

§ 226-79. Removal.

A. Any police officer is authorized to order the removal of any unregistered vehicle in violation of this Section to a storage space or garage, and the expense involved in such a removal and storage of the vehicle shall be borne by the owner of the vehicle, except that the expense shall be borne by the lessee of a leased vehicle.

§ 226-80. Penalty.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statutes, every person convicted of a violation of this article or any supplement thereto shall be liable for the penalties set forth in § 226-2 of the Code of the Township of Manalapan.

§ 226-81. through § 226-82. (Reserved)

Section II

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be judged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section III

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section IV

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
