Recycling Schedule for 2013

Commingles (Bottles, Cans & Plastic Containers), Newspaper & Cardboard (flattened and no larger than 3 ft. x 3 ft.) can all be put out on your designated Wednesday. Your Recycling collections are **every other Wednesday**.

Garbage/Recycling Holidays: New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day & Christmas Day

All Garbage and Recycling should be placed curbside the night before or prior to 6am the day of collection

USED OIL should be recycled at local gas stations or Hazardous Waste @ 732-683-8686

TIRES can be brought to the Reclamation Center or to Goodyear on Route 9 & Symmes @ 732-431-5552

LATEX PAINT CANS must be bone dry empty with the lids off for regular trash collection.

For questions or directions regarding Hazardous Waste, please call The Monmouth County Reclamation @ 732-683-8686.

Residents are allowed up to 6 - 64 gallon containers of household trash each collection day.

Two bulk items will be collected **once a month** on your last Thursday or Friday collection day of the month. Televisions, metal and white goods will not be collected curbside. These items can be brought to the Public Works Recycling Yard.

Yard debris/brush will no longer be accepted on any trash collection day. Spring brush collection by the Department of Public Works will begin on April 15, 2013. All debris must be placed curbside and not in the street. (For more information see back pages.)

Branches and brush from residents only (no commercial vehicles or landscapers) will be accepted on **Saturdays only**. Branches and brush will not be accepted in plastic bags. If you do transport your brush in plastic bags just dump the debris in the container & take your plastic bag back with you.

Manalapan Township Recycling Program

You can now place all recyclables in one bin for curbside collection!

What can I recycle?

Glass bottles & jars – clear, brown, & green only

Tin and aluminum cans

Aerosol cans (EMPTY only, no caps)

Metal jar lids (remove from jars)

PAPERS

Corrugated cardboard (flattened)

Paperboard boxes (e.g. cereal, pasta & tissue boxes)

Newspapers & inserts (no bags)

Magazines, brochures & catalogues

Mail & greeting cards

Office paper

Photo paper, wrapping paper, tissue paper

File folders

Phone books

Paperback books

Hardcover books with the cover removed

Paper bags

Empty paper and toilet paper rolls (the core)

Shredded paper (must be placed in a clear plastic bag.

This is the only exception to the “no plastic bags” rule)

PLASTICS

[Numbers for plastic containers are located on the bottom of the container in the center of a small triangle made of the recycling arrows symbol.]

#1 thru #6 Plastics - screw top and pourable* containers ONLY

**Pourable means the neck of the container is narrower than the body*

- **Remove Caps**

- Examples: **bottles from milk, water, detergent, & shampoo.**

Recycling Tips

Remove lids from jars and bottles

Empty and lightly rinse all containers

You do NOT need to tie up your newspapers if they are in a container

Use a container with a lid to ensure that papers do not blow away

Containers should not be larger than 64 gallons

Leaf Collection - Pursuant to Township ordinance #198-21, all leaves must be placed in biodegradable paper bags. Leaves placed in plastic bags will not be picked up from curb area or accepted at the Public Works yard. Leaf collection in the Spring will take place on April 8th and May 6th. Leaf collection this fall will be on **every Monday in November and December**. Please place bagged leaves at the curb, not in the street, on the **FIRST** day of each collection to insure you will not miss any of the collections. The exact day of leaf collection is impossible to determine. Bagged leaves containing twigs, grass, brush, weeds or other debris **will not be collected**.

Brush Collection - The Township will be collecting brush in the Spring beginning on April 15th. The Department of Public Works will be making one pass throughout the town. To insure that you are not missed, please make sure that all brush is placed neatly on the curb (not in the roadway) by this date. Should you miss this collection, brush can be brought to the Public Works yard on Saturdays only throughout the year between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Storm Damage - Any storm damage due to wind shears, hurricanes, tornadoes, or nor easters, as determined by the National Weather Service will be collected by the Department of Public Works. Residents must contact the Department of Public Works at 732-446-8403 to schedule a pick up. If the Department of Public Works is not notified within 2 weeks of a storm, removal of any storm damaged limbs will be the homeowner's responsibility.

Up to 200 pounds of dry materials or 20 gallons of liquid permitted per visit. No container can be larger than 5 gallons.
